Township Trustees develop newsletter for Annual Clean-up Day

As part of the 2009 Litter Cleanup Grant applied for and received by the Troy Township Trustees, we are making Township residents aware of our Annual Troy Township Cleanup Day on Saturday, April 25th from 8am to 2pm at the Troy Township Garage, located at 923 US Highway 224 Rear in Nova, behind the firehouse.

During this day, we will have two large trash containers, a recycling bin, a scrap metal trailer, and a container to accept used oil. Please bring your trash, recyclables, scrap metals, used oil, tires not on rims, and old vehicle batteries to our Township Building.

Please DO NOT bring the following, as we will not accept them:

- *No Hazardous Waste, *No Asbestos, *No Tires on rims, *No Freon,
- * No Auto Parts, *No Closed or Filled Steel Drums, *No Ashes,
- *No Animal Waste, *No Animals or Animal remains, *No Liquids, and *No Yard Waste.
